

Privacy policy

Pursuant to art. 13 of EU Reg. 2016/679

This Privacy Policy is applicable to personal data provided through using this website.

Data Controller: the data controller is Vincenzo Donatiello, Tax Code No. DNTVCN85L02B6190, domiciled in Strada Romano no. 3, 12051 Alba (Cn), VAT No.: 03637280045, info@poolwine.it.

Processing Purposes: the information provided when filling in contact forms and/or when sending e-mails, is used only for replying to your enquiries or for satisfying your requests.

Storage period: personal data will only be used for the length of time required for achieve the purposes established in the previous point or until such time as you declare your objection or until such time as you withdraw your consent. In any case, the personal data will not be stored for a period exceeding 10 years.

However, should the storage of your personal data be required for a longer period for legal reasons or where it is necessary to use your personal data to support or defend judicial enquiries, the said data shall be kept until the expiry of the relevant compulsory period of storage or until such time as the enquiries concerned are resolved.

Processing Methods: personal data processing may be carried out with or without the aid of electronic, or in any case, automatised means.

Subjects or categories of subjects to whom the data may be disclosed: here “disclosure” means making it known to one or more specific subjects.

The collected data may be communicated: 1) to subjects, either public and/or private, who may access the data on the authority of provisions of a legal, regulatory or community regulation nature and within the limits set by such regulations, such as, to give a non-exclusive example, social security and healthcare institutes and authorities, associations of local bodies, associations, foundations, authorities or agencies of an associative and/or insurance nature; 2) to subjects who need to access the data for purposes auxiliary to the relationship entered into by the parties, strictly within the limits required to complete the auxiliary tasks, to give a non-exclusive example, banks and credit institutes, companies providing services, carriers and courier companies; to our consultant subjects, within the limits required to complete their duties within our organisation, subject to our written notice of appointment imposing the duty of confidentiality and security.

Your personal data will not be disseminated by us, meaning with that term making it known to specific subjects in any way whatsoever, including by their availability

to it or consultation of it, unless with specific consent, free and informed, given expressly by yourself and granted for each type of processing.

Cookies: this website makes use of cookies.

A cookie is a text file that is memorised on computer, tablet, mobile telephones and on any device whatsoever that is used to browse on Internet, capable of memorising the browsing information of the user and his/her preferences.

While browsing, information can be collected regarding the traffic flow and the visits to the website pages.

Cookies may be subdivided into “technical” and “data profiling” types.

This website uses the so-called “technical” cookies solely for the purpose of making the transmission of a communication on an electronic network, or inasmuch as it is strictly necessary for the provider of a service explicitly requested by the user and in order to provide such service.

Some cookies may be used to make browsing easier and to customise the experience of browsing our website, they may indicate which parts of our website are being visited, so as to analyse the behaviour of users and improve our communications.

This website does not, on the other hand, make any use whatsoever of the so-called “data profiling” cookies, or in other words those aimed at creating profiles of the user and exploited in order to send them advertising messages in tune with the preferences revealed by them while browsing on the net.

This website makes use of so-called “third-party” cookies, aimed at receiving on your device, while browsing a website, cookies sent by other websites or other web servers and therefore filing of information occurs with third parties.

All information, obtained through the cookies, will be processed and stored securely. The purpose of using cookies is to customise access to the website, thus optimising browsing and the operation of the website, in order to improve our services and provide content and/or advertising relevant to the user preferences, by analysing their browsing habits.

Most browsers allow control and disabling of cookies through the settings.

Transfer of personal data to non-EU countries: this website might share some of the collected data with services localised outside of the European Union. In particular, with Google, LinkedIn and Facebook through the social network plugins and the Google Analytics service. The transfer is automatised.

Rights of the data subjects: information may be requested from the data controller at any time, regarding your personal data that is being processed, as well as rectification or erasure of such personal data; which, however, can only be erased if there is no prevalent obligation to store it under legislation or rights.

You may also request that processing of your data be restricted, if you declare that the personal data subject to processing is incorrect.

Requests should be addressed to info@poolwine.it, specifying the information or processing activities concerned, the format to be used for providing the information and whether the personal data is to be sent to you or to another recipient.

Your request will be given careful attention and the methods for complying with it will be discussed with you.

Right to lodge a complaint: if you should consider that your personal data is not being processed in accordance with the requisites laid down in this policy or by the standards of the EU Regulations on the protection of personal data, you are entitled to lodge a complaint at any time to the authority for the protection of personal data.

Legal basis for processing: all the personal information you provide is the result of your own free will and no unlawful means are used to obtain such information without your consent.

Right to confer your personal data: optional, explicit and voluntary sending of electronic mail, name, surname or other personal data to the e-mail address shown on this website and by means of the contact form, will lead to consequent acquisition of the address of the sender, which is needed in order to reply to the request, as well as any other personal data included in the message sent.

Location of the processing: the processing takes place at the domicile of the data controller as shown in this policy document.

Data Processor: Google is the appointed data processor, inasmuch as it processes data on behalf of the owner (data processing carried out by Google Analytics).
